Report on the Financial Statements

I have audited the financial statements of the ADHD Association Inc. which comprise the balance sheet as at 31 March 2020 and the income and expenditure account for the year then ended.

ADHD Association Inc. Committee's Responsibility for the Financial Statements The ADHD Association Inc. Committee is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice in New Zealand and for such internal control as the committee determine is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit. An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my qualified audit opinion on the financial position and performance.

I have no relationship with or interest in the ADHD Association Inc.

Basis for Qualified Opinion on Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account In common with other organisations of a similar nature control over cash receipts prior to being recorded, and internal controls in general, are limited and there are no practical audit procedures to determine the effect of this limited control. Accordingly, the completeness of revenue and retained earnings is unable to be determined.

Qualified Opinion on Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account

In my opinion, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the financial statements

- Comply with generally accepted accounting practice in New Zealand,
